For the student:

1. Zipper pouch for school supplies. No pencil boxes, please. The following items will be in the pencil pouch:
 - a. Scissors
 - b. 24-pack of crayons (Crayola preferred.)
 - c. 24-pack of colored pencils (Crayola preferred.)
 - d. Highlighters (five color pack)
 - e. 1 glue stick (See #2.)
 - f. 5 pencils (See #3.)

3. 18 count pencils (Ticonderoga preferred.) Most pencils will be collected for the classroom community to use throughout the year.
